Dear Salt River Brass Fans,

The highest priority of the Salt River Brass is the health and well-being of our fans and our musicians, and their families. Due to the rapidly evolving situation surrounding the COVID-19 Pandemic, our March 22, 2020 concert at the Mesa Arts Center has been canceled, effective immediately. We will be making a decision about our April 26, 2020 concert within the next few weeks.

While this is a difficult decision, we are currently in the midst of an unprecedented health crisis and the Salt River Brass is committed to protecting our community.

Ticket holders for the March concert have the following options:

1. Please consider donating your tickets back to the Salt River Brass and receive a tax-deductible donation. As a nonprofit organization, the Salt River Brass relies on the generous support of our fans. To donate the value of your tickets, please contact the Mesa Arts Center Box Office at 480-644-6500 or by email at boxoffice@mesaartscenter.com no later than March 22.
2. For those not donating back your tickets, the Mesa Arts Center Box Office will begin refunding the full amount of your ticket purchase back to the original credit card on March 23rd (please allow 3-5 business days). In the event your purchase was made by cash or check, your refund will be issued in the form of a check and mailed out within three weeks.

The Salt River Brass is closely monitoring the situation and we will let you know our decision regarding our April 26 concert soon.
